



Item 3 – BUDGET

Description:

For the year of 2018, there is no separate budget for the association. All funding of 2018 is therefore totally relying on the National Pilgrim Centre in Norway.

Proposed budget for 2019 is based on the experience from the Via Francigena association in Italy. Via Francigena is a comparable association, being a pilgrim route that crosses through several countries. The Via Francigena is also a certified European Cultural Route.

Item 4 – MEMBERSHIP FEES

Description:

Membership fees to ACSOW will need to cover 3/4 of the associations budget. For the initial years of the association, the proposed budget is $100\ 000\ €$. In comparison to Via Francigena, a well-established association, they operate with an annual cost around $285\ 000\ €$ and an annual income around $300\ 000\ €$.

The General Assembly in February 2018, decided on a differentiated membership fee as follows:

National Government funded institutions or private companies	100 000,-
County councils	100 000,-
Regional centres / Municipalities	10 000,-
Museums	10 000,-
Universities / Research institutes	10 000,-
Non-profit pilgrim organisations	5000,-

Governing Board members have argued for a new proposal to be presented at the Extraordinary General Assembly, to ensure that the question of membership fee is decided democratically among its new members.

The new proposal is also a differentiated model, but with alterations in fees.







Proposed membership fees for ACSOW:
